Sitemap Generator & Sitemap Editor

The Sitemap protocol is an established standard to inform major search engines like Google about pages on your site available for crawling, how often each page will usually change and how important each page is, relative to other pages on your site. Nowadays, having a Sitemap is an important factor of search engine optimization. It is usually the only up-to-date page where all of your pages are listed in one place.

By using a Sitemap, you push all your pages to the search engines to get crawled faster, more efficiently and in a more timely fashion. iGooMap will help you to improve your site's visibility in search results and might even help you to diagnose problems.

With iGooMap, you can automatically create XML Sitemaps conforming to the protocol, upload to your server and notify all search engines supporting sitemaps.

Key Features:

- Easy to use, just enter the URL of your web site.
- Scan multiple web sites at once.
- Scanning of sites created with iWeb and upload to your iDisk.
- Automatically apply defaults for priority, change frequency and date modified.
- Ability to pause and continue web site scans.
- Respects your robots.txt file.
- Exclude files or folders from scanning with filters.
- You can set file extensions to be scanned and listed.
- You can specify parameters to remove from each URL, like session IDs, to prevent redundant or incomplete crawling.
- Only working URLs are included in the listing.
- Shows you the rejected links and the corresponding reasons.
- Import of an existing sitemap XML file or a text file containing URLs; either from local files or from your server.
- Edit the settings of scanned or imported URLs easily in the list.
- Add, remove or edit the URLs listed individually or in batch.
- Apply URL settings like priority by importing from an existing sitemap.
- Save each sitemap configuration in a document for easy maintenance.
- Export as sitemap XML file or URL listing.
- Generates Sitemaps conforming to the XML Sitemap protocol standard.
- Integrated FTP, SFTP and iDisk sitemap upload to your server.
- Automatic search engine notifications (Google, Yahoo!, Ask.com, Live.com and Moreover.com).

Although not necessary to submit Sitemaps, with a Google account you will be able to use diagnostic tools to check your site submissions, see www.google.com/webmastertools

In order to share your sitemap with the crawlers at large, simply provide the following line in your robots.txt:

Sitemap: <complete URL of your Sitemap>

Example: Sitemap: <http://www.pointworks.de/sitemap.xml>

Installation

Drag the iGooMap icon from the disk image to the Applications folder on your hard disk.

System Requirements

- Mac OS X 10.4 or later
- Internet connection

iGooMap is offered as shareware and can be easily and conveniently purchased here:


This link you can also reach over the menu "Purchase/Purchase Online...". Here you will find also the actual payment terms.

After your registration you will get your personal license file by return of eMail. Start up iGooMap and select in the menu „Purchase“ and than „Unlock...“ to open your license file. Your iGooMap is licensed now.

Getting Started



Enter the URL in the field labeled “URL1” and press the “Start” button. iGooMap start scanning your site immediately and you will see the results in the list while iGooMap is crawling your pages for links. You can cancel or halt the scan anytime by clicking the „Stop“ or „Pause“ button.

iGooMap will use all links on your pages, in accordance with the Sitemap protocol i.e.:

- The URLs must be on the same host. It even matters, if your using the *www.* prefix or not. So if you enter *www.pointworks.de* for scanning and iGooMap finds *pointworks.de*, it will add the prefix. External hosts are always rejected.
- All URLs in a Sitemap must use the same scheme (a scheme is the *http://* part). If the scheme of a fully specified URL doesn't match, it will be rejected (e.g. *file://*).
- Only URLs in the path you've started from are scanned. If you enter e.g. *www.pointworks.de/path/* anything below */path* will be crawled. To scan your entire site, use always the host part only: *www.pointworks.de/*
- If a URL responds with any HTTP error (like 404, not found) it is not included in the result.

If you are using a *robots.txt*, anything disallowed for the Googlebot is also disallowed for iGooMap and will be rejected. If you don't want this behaviour, select another User-Agent in iGooMap/Preferences/Download. The default User-Agent is „Google“.

If iGooMap timed out while waiting for a server response, the scan process is halted. This is necessary to avoid an incomplete scan of your site. You can set the time out interval used in iGooMap/Preferences/Download. The default is 60 seconds.

For scanning a **MobileMe** (dotMac) hosted site, please enter: http://web.me.com/your_member_name/.
If you have multiple sites created, enter: http://web.me.com/your_member_name/your_site_folder_name/

Rejected Links

iGooMap shows you the rejected links while scanning your pages. Select the menu „View“ and than „Show Rejected Links“ or click in the disclosure triangle in the lower left corner of the window. This will open or close the drawer, depending on it's current state.

Links colored in blue

This links are rejected in accordance to the user settings.

Links colored in red

An error occured (server response). You should check this link.

Other Links

Rejected by any other reason, probably ok.


Options

Open the options drawer by clicking on “Options” button in the toolbar. This will open or close the drawer, depending on it’s current state.



General

These settings are the default options applied to every URL scanned.



Priority:

The priority of a URL relative to other URLs on your site. This value has no effect on your pages compared to pages on other sites, and only lets the search engines know which of your pages you deem most important so they can order the crawl of your pages in the way you would most like. The default priority is 0.5.

Change Frequency:

How frequently the page is likely to change. This value provides general information to search engines and may not correlate exactly to how often they crawl the page. The default change frequency is weekly.

Modified Date:

The date of last modification of the pages. If you select “From File”, the server provided last modification date is used (http header response). Today is - well - today. The default selection is “From File”. Please note, that dynamically generated pages (like .php) are always set to the date the response was sent. Only static pages (like .html) provides a last modified date.

File Extensions Allowed:

Only links to pages ending with one of the extension in the list will be scanned and listed. To add or remove an entry, click the +/- button in the lower left corner. To edit an entry, double click on that row. You may add or remove file extensions to suite your needs. Please enter the extension without a leading point. If you enter a wildcard symbol * (asterisk), you allow any extension.


Parameters to Remove:

Parameters with one of the names provided in this list will be removed from the URL query string before the URL is crawled and added to the list. To add or remove an entry, click the +/- button in the lower left corner. To edit an entry, double click on that row. The default setup should remove any session IDs to prevent redundant or incomplete crawling. You may add or remove parameters to suite your needs. If you want to read more [about session IDs, click here](#). Please enter only the name of the parameter to remove, see below:

A query is the part behind the ? character in a URL e.g. ?page=content, where page is the name of the parameter and content is the variable. ?page=content will be removed if you enter „page“.

Filter

If you don't use a robots.txt file on your server or want to disallow additional files or folders, you may enter the path in this list. The used syntax is nearly the same as used in a robots file. You find more information [about robots.txt here](#).



To add or remove an entry, click the +/- button in the lower left corner. To edit an entry, double click on the row. The specified files or folders are neither scanned nor included in the result.

Some examples:

`/private/` - to exclude any files in a path *starting* with `/private/`

Example: `www.pointworks.de/private/...`

`private/` - to exclude any files in a path *containing* `private/`

Example: `www.pointworks.de/private/privacy.html`

and also: `www.pointworks.de/public/private/...`

`/privacy.html` - to exclude any file in a path *starting* with `/privacy.html`

Example: `www.pointworks.de/privacy.html`

`privacy.html` - to exclude any file in a path *containing* `privacy.html`

Example: `www.pointworks.de/private/privacy.html`

and also: `www.pointworks.de/public/private.html`

You may combine this:


`/public/files.html` - exclude `files.html` if it is in the exact path.

`public/files.html` - exclude `files.html` in any folder named `public`.

Please enter only the path, NOT the complete URL.

Publishing

For using the „Publish“ button later, you have to enter your FTP, SFTP or MobileMe account data here. Don't worry, the password is stored secure in your keychain and not in the iGooMap Document.

Protocol:

Select the protocol to use for the transfer. Available options are FTP, SFTP (Secure FTP) or MobileMe. The default option selected is FTP.

Port:

The default port will be set by iGooMap. You don't have to change this option if your server responds through the standard ports. If MobileMe is selected as protocol, you can't change this value.

Server:

Enter the address of your server without the scheme part (ftp://).

Examples: ftp.pointworks.de, www.pointworks.de.

If MobileMe is selected as protocol, the server is always set to: idisk.mac.com.

User:

Please enter your user name (also called login name or member name).

Password:

Enter your password. For security reasons, only are displayed and the password is stored in your keychain. If you install a newer version of iGooMap, it will ask you for permission to access the password in your keychain.

Directory:

Usually the root directory of your site. Examples: public_html, htdocs, httpdocs, www. The directory used by MobileMe and iWeb is usually: /Web/Sites/. If you leave this field blank, iGooMap uses the root directory by default.

Search Engines to Notify:

Select the search engines pinged after a successful upload of your Sitemap.

**It is strongly recommended that you place your Sitemap at the root directory of your server.
Example: <http://www.pointworks.de/sitemap.xml>.**

Finally

If the scanning is complete, you have the following options to make changes. You'll find the corresponding menu commands and key equivalents in the „Sitemap“ menu.

Add or Remove a URL:

Click on the + button in the lower right corner to add a URL. You can verify your input later by holding down the option (⌘) key while double click on the URL or select „Open Link(s) in Browser“ from the Sitemap menu. This will open the selected URLs in your default web browser. To remove URLs, select one or more from the list and click the - button.

Edit:

Just double click on the URL listed in the Pages column.

Changing Priority or Frequency:

Select the new value from the popup menu in the appropriate row and column.

Sorting and more:


You can sort the result ascending or descending by clicking in the appropriate column title. You can re-order or resize the columns by selecting the title and dragging around.

Import Settings from a previously created sitemap:

You can import and apply setting to each URL from a previously created sitemap, either from disk or from your server. See „Import / Import of Settings Only“ for details.

Batch editing of Priority or Frequency:

Select multiple URLs by shift (⇧) and/or command- click (⌘) in the list. Choose the new value by ctrl-click (or right-click) in any of the selected rows in the appropriate column (Frequency, Priority).



Import

You can import URLs from an existing file. The imported file must be either a Sitemap XML format or a text file (one URL per line).

From Local File

To import a file from your disk select from the Sitemap menu „Import / From Local File“. The following dialog displays for the import only files with XML format or text files.

From Remote File

To import a file from an Internet server select from the Sitemap menu „Import/From Remote File“. Please enter the corresponding URL. Example: <http://www.pointworks.de/sitemap.xml>

Import of Settings Only

If there are already URLs listed in your iGooMap document, you can use the option „Apply Settings Only“. This option is only enabled for xml files.

If selected, the URL settings (Frequency, Priority, Last Modified Date) from the imported file are applied to each similar URL listed in your iGooMap document. This will neither replace nor add any URLs to your iGooMap document.

Export

You can save your Sitemap in a XML format (sitemap.xml) or as text file (urllist.txt). The text file provides more limited information (just the URLs) and should only be used for other programs.

If possible use always a XML file as the additional informations like frequency, priority and last modified date are only saved in a XML file.

Publish

Once you are satisfied with the result, click the „Publish“ button to transfer your Sitemap to your server and notify the selected search engines. A file named „sitemap.xml“ will be created in the directory specified by the account settings - usually the root directory.

If you want to upload the sitemap yourself or view the created XML Sitemap file in a text editor, click the „Export“ button and choose the „XML Sitemap“ format.


You should save the document now. iGooMap uses a multi-document architecture. The idea is to save the complete setup for scanning a single web site and transferring the sitemap (Publishing Account) for each server. The next time you open your saved document, you just have to click the „Start“ button - wait for the crawler to complete - click the „Publish“ button and you are done.

You should create a new sitemap each time you add or remove a page to your site or if the content has changed much.

You may want to use the settings from a previously created sitemap. Please see section [Import:Import of Settings Only](#) for details.

iGooMap Global Preferences

Select the menu „iGooMap“ and than „Preferences...“ to open the Preferences dialog.




When iGooMap starts: Open new Document

If selected, iGooMap will open a new, untitled document at start up. This option is selected by default.

When iGooMap starts: Check for updates

If selected, iGooMap will check for new versions at start up automatically. You can initiate the check manually from the iGooMap menu. This option is selected by default.



Timeout after: x seconds

This specifies the number of seconds iGooMap wait for any server response. The default value is 60 seconds.

User Agent

This specifies the User-Agent identifier used when iGooMap connecting to the server. The default identifier is „Google“. iGooMap rejects files or folders disallowed by your robots.txt for the selected User-Agent.

Troubleshooting

If iGooMap cannot find any or only some links the reasons could be as follows:

Inconsistent URL host

You are using another host or a BASE HREF instruction on your site, which is not conform with your input. The Google schema intends filing your URL and links either with www.pointworks.de or pointworks.de.

You are using Macromedia Flash for your entire site

Flash is not a markup language for web pages and contains no search engine usable data. Neither links nor any text content or the semantics of the page can be extracted. If you must using Flash, provide also text links to pages written in HTML.

You are using JavaScript to create the links

You should provide some static text links also. Something like `document.write()` isn't a good link to follow, neither for iGooMap nor Google.

If you like to see your page like Google does, use "View Source" in your Browser.
